There will also be prizes for the winners of each year group. We're also inviting the children in **Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6** to take part in the 'Easter Egg Competition', where they can design their very own scene involving an egg! We've had some amazing creations in the past and we can't wait to see what you come up with again this year! There are some ideas below to help you get started, and of course, there will be prizes for the winners of each year group. Any entries for this competition are to be brought into school on the day please.

Egg Hunt

After school, we're hosting the St. Leonard's Big Easter Egg Hunt! On the day, each child taking part will leave school with the instructions for the egg hunt. Dotted around the school will be members of staff, offering treats, activities and lots of encouragement to help you on your way. Once you've completed the trail, head to the hall, where Mrs Cullen will be waiting with a huge selection of Easter eggs for you to choose from.

The cost of the Egg Hunt is £3.50 and the closing date to sign up on ParentPay is Monday 23rd March. This activity takes place after school and parents will need to accompany their children around the trail. All money raised will continue to go towards our ongoing efforts to improve the technology for the children within school.

Easter Raffle

You will have seen on the dates list that each year, our School Council organise an Easter raffle for a chance to win one of 20 amazing chocolate hampers! There will be a non-school uniform day on Friday 20th March, where children are asked to bring in some chocolate to donate towards this. Raffle tickets will then be on sale at breaktime on Monday 23rd, Tuesday 24th and Wednesday 25th March and the raffle will be drawn on Thursday 26th during worship. School Council will also visit Robins to sell tickets to them during the day. Tickets are 50p each and will go straight into the jar – no tickets will be coming home.
